Office of the Governor

Executive Order

By the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and the laws of the Oklahoma Intercollegiate Legislature, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section One. Any person currently holding an office which places them on the Oklahoma Intercollegiate Board of Directors shall not be denied access by any person or entity to official organization events and activities, for any reason. This includes but is not limited to general session, committees, official lunch activities, legislative chambers, court proceedings, and places designated as executive offices. The presence of a badge issued by the Secretary of State is not required to exercise these rights.

Section Two. As members of the Office of the Governor are an extension of the Governor's authority, any member of the Office of the Governor on official executive or organization business shall not be denied access by any person or entity to official organization events and activities, for any reason. This includes but is not limited to general session, committees, official lunch activities, legislative chambers, court proceedings, and places designated as executive offices. This section also shall be construed to extend these rights to elected executive officials. The presence of a badge issued by the Secretary of State is required to exercise these rights.

Section Three, Exceptions. Provisions stated in Sections One and Two of this order do not apply in the following circumstances: (1) Where a member of the Board of Directors or Office of the Governor has not paid required dues to attend session or entertainment pass events and (2) where the rights conveyed in Sections One and Two of this order have been revoked by a majority vote of the Board of Directors, in which he or she is allowed to vote if he or she is member of the Board of Directors. Such revocation shall only last until the end of the legislative day or to the end of the specific entertainment pass event.

Section Four, Definitions. "Official executive or organization business" is defined as orders or directives given to a member of the Office of the Governor by the Governor, other executive official, or business arising out of his or her specific duties to the organization. No other member of the organization may determine if a specific business responsibility falls underneath the provided definition of what is "official executive or organization business" for the purposes of this act, other than the Governor or Attorney General.

Section Four. This order shall render null and void any conflicting regulations or rules.
