OPINION 2016-24F

Honorable Delegates and Members,

There has been another official legally binding opinion requested. The question submitted is "Is it in the opinion of the Attorney General that the Governor may call for an emergency steering meeting before post mortem occurs?"

My opinion is yes, but with one stipulation.

Title Two, Chapter Two, Section 202, Sub-Section A of the OIL Statutes state that "The Steering Committee shall meet after the conclusion of each regular conference of the Organization; such meetings designated "Post Mortem Session."". Under Title Two, Chapter Two, Section 202, Sub-Section C of the OIL Statutes states that "The Governor may call additional meetings of the Steering Committee as needed."

So, it is in my opinion that as long as the Steering Committee has scheduled the "Post Mortem Session", that the Governor may in fact call a meeting of the Steering Committee before the "Post Mortem Session" takes place.
