EXECUTIVE ORDER
SS-2022-001

- Section 1: I, Emmett G. Thompson, Governor of the Oklahoma Intercollegiate Legislature, pursuant to the authority, powers, and virtues vested in me by Article Five, Section Two of the Oklahoma Intercollegiate Legislature Constitution, am hereby calling the House of Representatives and the Senate to convene for the First Special Session of the Fifty-Third Oklahoma Intercollegiate Legislature.
- Section 2: This meeting shall begin upon the adjournment of the Steering Committee Meeting of the Fall 2022 Interim Session on Sunday, October 23rd, 2022. This meeting shall be held via video conference and shall not last longer than two hours.
- Section 3: The purpose and call of this Special Session shall only be to consider internal legislation authorizing and appropriating funds for general conference expenses.
- Section 4: As this is an extraordinary session, registration shall be conducted in a different manner than regular session. Registration shall be as follows:
- A. Registration shall be modeled after the "super-delegate" system.
 - B. Each delegation will have the same number of voting delegates that their delegation possessed at the Spring 2022 Regular Session.
 - C. Any other delegates other than the total number of voting delegates sent by the school shall be non-voting, alternative delegates that will have all privileges delegated to them by each Chamber's standing rules, provided that they shall not be permitted to vote on the final passage of any legislation.

- D. Any delegate registered to be a “voting delegate” must have attended the Spring 2022 Regular Session. Any other delegate who did not attend the Spring 2022 Regular Session but has attended a previous Regular Session must be registered as a non-voting, alternative delegate.
- E. There shall be no registration costs to attend Special Session.
- F. Each school shall conform to other regulations as directed by the Attorney General and Secretary of State.
- G. It shall be up to the discretion of each respective Delegation Chair on the selection of which delegates they register for this Special Session and how many votes are allocated to each voting delegate.
- H. I hereby direct the Attorney General and Secretary of State to develop regulations for the operations of Special Session, provided that they are consistent with this executive order.
