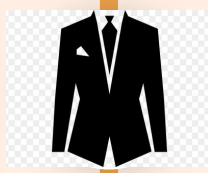


Navigating the Capitol during O.I.L.

Floor 5



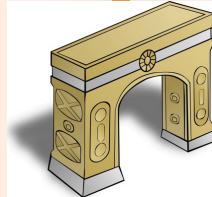
This floor is where you will reach the majority of our highest leadership since it's where the executive offices lie. You also can find the house temporarily located up here, so, this floor, too is, quite lively.

Floor 4

Floor 3
